- ⓪ Recipient agrees to share the results of the study, via a short oral report at the end of the business meeting, to the Guild within eight (8) months of the completion of the study.
- ⓪ Recipient is not eligible for funds again for two (2) years from the date of the study.
- ⓪ In the event the class or workshop is canceled, recipient may request permission to enroll in another event of similar interest and benefit, during the same Guild year. Funds not used must be returned to the Guild.
- ⓪ Minimum estimated cost of workshop must be equal or greater than the Study Funds requested.
